It provides a live tissue experience in a wide variety of life saving critical skills and procedures. Utilizing a team approach in a 1:2 or 2:4 instructor to student ratio. Procedures include airway management, chest tube insertion, central line placement, suprapubic catheterization, internal cardiac massage and a variety of other procedures.
